Sabbath Rules for Caterers at Maimonides School

1. No food, utensils or equipment may be brought to the school after sunset on Fridays.
2. The flame must be covered with a metal covering before sunset, and the knobs must also be covered or removed.
3. All the food - that will be served warm - must be on the stove--covering before sunset.
4. The food may be removed from the stove only after nightfall (Friday night). These may then be placed in a refrigerator.
5. Any kettle or cauldron of water must remain on the stove-covering on the Sabbath. No water may be added to the cauldron on the Sabbath.
6. Any solid foods (not liquid foods or gravy) may be removed from the refrigerator and placed on the stove-covering provided that points #3 and 4 were attended to.
7. Liquid foods (gravy or soup, etc.) may not be placed on the stove-covering on the Sabbath.
8. One may place a vessel with gravy (or other liquid foods) into a cauldron of hot water which is on the stove-covering.
9. One may not take any of the food, vessels or equipment out of Maimonides School on the Sabbath.
10. The kitchen is not to be opened for any purpose if there is no rabbinic supervision present to supervise the implementation of the aforementioned rules.
